Mayor Kleisle welcomed everyone and introduced Eric Morris, Research Associate and Joseph Stefko, Project Director, from the Center for Governmental Research, (CGR).

Mr. Stefko gave a brief background on CGR. In 2010 the Village of Lyons, Town of Lyons and Lyons Central School District decided to jointly pursue a grant from New York State to study possible shared service/consolidate opportunities in six functional service areas: Code Enforcement, Courts, Department of Public Works and Highway, Parks and Recreation, Shared Administration, and Shared Benefits. They analyzed both what exists and what opportunities are available to the community in the six areas. He stated their mission is to bring prospective on the best practices with more critical eyes to increase efficiency in communities. He commended Lyons for demonstrating a willingness to work together in the Town, School and Village. We have a Shared Services Committee established and look for opportunities to drive down costs.

Mr. Morris presented the findings of their study. He completed his presentation at 7:20 P.M. and opened the meeting to questions.

Mr. Morris stated he will leave the public comments opened for a few weeks then add them to the final report as an addendum.
